SUNDAY, 19th APRIL 2026 - Departing at 8.30am from the Old Gaol at Meadow Street, Guildford, we will be chauffeured by King Mini Bus Charters to York where we will meet with our guide, Ken Emberson. Ken will share his historical knowledge as we are transported through time, stopping to get off at Mt Brown Lookout and at the Residency Museum (site of the old Convict Depot). From there, we will return to town for lunch at the Settler's Inn (at own cost).

With time to wander the main streets and surrounding historical buildings, we suggest checking out one or two places of interest (more info and map will be given to those who register).

Make sure you save your appetite for desserts because, back on board the bus, we will make a brief stop at the York Ice-Cream Co. (the Olive Farm), 10 minutes out of town.

Arrival back at Guildford is approximately 4.45pm.
