

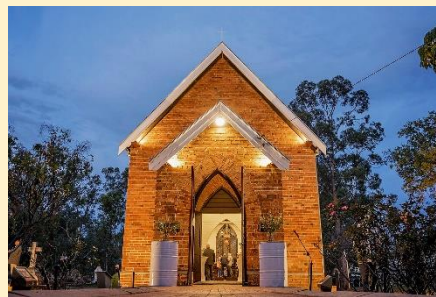
Evendale Heritage Precinct, Pinjarra
